Looking for some peaceful nature, away from the busy noisy centre? Here are plenty of parks to choose from:

KRALINGSE BOS | Everyone probably heard of Kralingse bos already, the lake on the North-East side of the city.

HET PARK | But have you seen the big park next to Euromast, south of the city centre? In fall you can take a peaceful hike whilst enjoying the charming trees. In spring take a nap in the sun by the water, after admiring the blooming flowers around you.

ZUIDERPARK | Looking for a more open area-kind-of park? The park next to Shopping centre Zuidplein is perfect to have a walk after having lunch by a sunny bench inside the park.
